Three Policy objectives and two enablers

Phase 1 – PILOTING

The Mission Ocean and Waters piloting phase (2022-2025) focused on implementing solutions within four lighthouse regions: Atlantic-Arctic, Mediterranean, Baltic-North Sea, and Danube-Black Sea. Each region concentrated on 1 specific objective.

Key components

- **Regional Lighthouses:** These area-based sites act as the central hubs for piloting activities.
- **Research and Innovation (R&I):** The plan relies on R&I projects funded through Horizon Europe to develop the necessary solutions. Over 330 demonstration sites are already operational across various projects.
- **Implementation Platform:** A dedicated platform was established (operational since February 2023) to coordinate and integrate activities across the different Mission lighthouses, acting as a one-stop-shop for project coordination.
- **Community and Stakeholder Engagement:** The piloting phase involves developing participatory processes and providing direct support (technical assistance, feasibility studies) to key communities, including ports, fisheries, and island communities. This is to ensure broad participation and the eventual social and political acceptance of restoration actions.



Phase 2 – DEPLOYMENT (utrulling, implementering)

The Mission Ocean and Waters deployment phase (2026-2030) focuses on scaling up and replicating solutions developed during the initial phase (2022-2025) across all "lighthouse" areas

Key components

Political anchoring: Mission as delivery mechanism for European Ocean Pact, European Water Resilience Strategy

Broad participation and governance: The plan emphasizes enabling broad participation from citizens, stakeholders, and communities, fostering a strong governance element across all lighthouses and at national level

• **Deployment and replication:** Solutions that were developed and piloted in Phase 1 will be deployed, replicated, and scaled up across all sea and river basins.

• **Support for authorities and communities:** Practical and accessible support will be provided to relevant authorities and communities to help facilitate the large-scale implementation of innovative measures.

• **Open calls:** Calls will be launched to support the scale-up of innovative actions that contribute to the Mission's objectives.

• **Shift from thematic focus:** The thematic compartmentalization by geographic area seen in Phase 1 will be reduced, allowing for a more integrated deployment of solutions across all basins.



- **Purpose**

BlueActionAA

- BlueActionAA Community-Led Pilot Action Call (BAAC-01) is focused on community-led actions.
- Community-led actions are defined as **regional and local communities** engaged in collective collaboration for innovation and uptake, acting as agents of change and long-term impact.
- BAAC-01 aims to mobilise and engage communities across the Atlantic and Arctic regions in ambitious efforts to make progress toward all of the objectives of the EU Mission “Restore our Ocean and Waters by 2030” (Mission Ocean and Waters)

BlueActionBANOS

- The BlueActionBANOS Community-Led Actions Open Call seeks to fund initiatives led by **area-based** or **interest-based stakeholder groups** within Baltic and North Sea (BANOS) countries that contribute to Mission Ocean and Waters objectives.
- Focus: Protecting and restoring marine and freshwater ecosystems and biodiversity. Preventing and eliminating pollution. Fostering a carbon-neutral and circular sustainable blue economy.
- The initiatives should meet these challenges with impactful solutions that are innovative for their community.

Technical support (example **BlueActionAA**)

- Needs are identified early – by yourself(!)
 - Applicants must explain expected barriers, challenges, and expertise gaps in their proposal. --> The earlier you inform us about your expected needs, the better for you.
- Three ways to address gaps (cf. Call description!)

Applicants can:

 - Work with external experts,
 - Request limited, targeted BlueActionAA assistance,
 - Join the BlueActionAA Technical Assistance Mentoring Programme
- Mentoring option available

Connects projects with experienced experts to strengthen both technical skills and collaboration capacity.
- Agreed upon *before* grant signature
 - Final technical assistance plans are confirmed before the grant agreement is signed and depend on the project scope and complexity.

8. Check for potential conflict of interest (Col)

Capital or personal connections such as:

- **ownership** relations;
- **family and personal** relationships; **unngå for Guds skyld koblinger til Epstein....**
- **material, especially financial** relationships ;
- **employment, cooperation or existing civil contract**;
- remaining in a **legal or factual relationship** that may give rise to justified **doubts as to the impartiality** of the people involved in the selection process.

- > if they occur at the time of an action or have occurred in the past (during the last 3 years before the action starts). Time limits do not apply to family and personal relationships.

All cases of Col will be assessed on a case-by –case basis.



Can one entity apply with different consortia?


Within one programme: Yes, but an entity can only receive a grant from BlueActionBANOS once. Consequently, if both projects are successful, your entity would have to participate in one of them without a budget (i.e., for €0).

Within two different programmes: one entity can participate in only one programme under BlueActionBANOS. Therefore, you should decide from the outset whether to apply to the Community-Led Actions (CLAs) or the 1st Transition Agendas (1st TAs) Open Call.

The selection process consists of the following 5 steps:

Independent Evaluation criteria (eksempel BlueActionBANOS)

(1) **RELEVANCE**- relevance of the proposed project to the Call

- Ambition - proposal's relevance to the Call objectives and expected results.
- Innovation *defined in relation to the area-based context of the proposed project*
- Soundness of the approach and credibility/ feasibility of the proposed methodology

2) **IMPACT**

- Measurable impact
- Societal impact
- Economic/Technological impact

(3) **IMPLEMENTATION** - quality of the proposed project design and plan

- Work Plan
- Resources
- Team
- Stakeholder and/or citizen engagement

Community-Led Actions (CLAs) Open Call

- **Focus:** Driving concrete actions to restore oceans, seas, and waters in the Baltic and North Sea (BANOS) Lighthouse area, focusing on Mission Ocean objectives: **pollution reduction, ecosystem restoration, and blue economy practices.**
- **Who Can Apply:** Consortia of 2-12 entities such as local (public and/or private) actors such as municipalities/regions, civil society organisations, private sector stakeholders, NGOs, foundations, educational establishments, locally based companies, and research organisations.
